Dear FAW Students and Families of Rising Grades 1-5,

Summer is just around the corner and with its arrival comes the opportunity to plan for great summer reading choices. We encourage our children to continue to make reading an important part of their daily schedule, even during the summer. To help with this, I encourage you to visit the public library throughout the summer. They have a great reading program for children of all ages.

Our summer reading program consists of reading, a project assignment and Language Arts and Math IXL. **First, all students should read at least 2 books (one required and one of your choice)**. You may certainly read more, and be sure to keep a log of your reading to share with your teacher when you return in the fall. The required books are as follows, by grade (for 2019-2020):

- Grade 1 Pedro, First-Grade Hero by Fran Manushkin
- Grade 2 Cam Jansen and the Mystery of the Babe Ruth Baseball by David Adler
- Grade 3- <u>Hurricane Heroes in Texas</u> by Mary Pope Osborne OR <u>Texas</u>: <u>A Nonfiction</u> <u>Companion to Hurricane Heroes in Texas</u> by Mary Pope Osborne
 - Grade 4- <u>Ribsy</u> by Beverly Cleary
 - Grade 5- Restart by Gordon Korman OR The 6th Grade Nickname Game by Gordon Korman
- 5 After reading the required book for your grade, each student should complete either a diorama or a descriptive poster and return it to school by September 9th. These projects should be completed by the student and will be shared with your class during library time.

All students should complete at least 10 Language Arts and 10 Math IXL lessons (your choice of lessons from the grade level you have just left). These lessons should be completed to a score of at least 85%. Please record the lessons you complete and turn this list in with your reading project.

Have a great summer and thank you for making reading a family priority this summer and always.
