FAW Hot Lunch for September 2020

Greetings FAW families,

As we start to prepare for the upcoming school year, I wanted to let everyone know that the hot lunch menu for September is now active. The first day for hot lunch will be **August 31st**.

I have consulted with our representative at the health department and we are able to continue to do many things that the students are used to even though they will start out eating lunch in their classrooms. In order to limit contact and comply with social distancing, I will be delivering lunch to each classroom by cart during their appropriate lunch period. I will have the fruit, desserts and milk with me, so the students will have to take everything while I am there as we won't be able to accommodate later in their lunch time, as we have in the past, if they forget to ask for something.

When you see the menu, you may notice that I have not listed sides as I normally would, but that is to offer some flexibility if items are hard to come by. You may also notice that the PB&J option has changed. While the students are eating in the classrooms, we will be switching to a peanut free option, specifically using Sunbutter. Our US Foods representative has assured me he will be able to supply Sunwise sunbutter and grape jelly sandwiches. On the off chance that he needs to supply us with something else, I can keep you updated or if you have concerns about it, please let me know.
