notice to the SCRIP team. If you are in need of plastic cards, please email faw.scrip@gmail.com and we will try to meet your gift card needs if at all possible.



Handbook Highlight: "Forms are sent home the first week of school for parents to fill out with emergency phone numbers and medical information. IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT THESE FORMS BE RETURNED PROMPTLY AND THE INFORMATION IS KEPT UP TO DATE. Parents will also be asked to provide contact information and dismissal directions in the event of an emergency school closing. Parents should have another contact besides themselves on the emergency form. Also, if there are any changes to regular contact or emergency contact information during the school year, the school office MUST be notified."

Early Pickup Procedure Reminder:

Parents are encouraged to make all medical and non-medical appointments outside of school hours and must notify the school via note and/or phone call when a late arrival or early dismissal is necessary. If an early dismissal is necessary, parents should remain in their vehicle when they arrive, call the school, and a staff member will escort the student to the parent.
