
We are looking for cheerful and positive parents and community members who would be available 7:45am - 2:45pm to substitute for teachers as needed throughout the year.

Child Protection Volunteer Requirements: For our new families and as a reminder for our returning families, don't forget the archdiocesan requirements for anyone who wishes to volunteer for activities that involve interaction with our children (ex. coaching, classroom or cafeteria helper, chaperone on field trips, etc.). The Archdiocese of Washington Child Protection Policy requires volunteers in parishes and schools to set up an account at virtus.org, complete a volunteer application and electronic background check, and attend a (virtual) training session on the Child Protection Policy. Upon completion of the training session, the last page in the policy book must be signed and returned to the school office. No one may volunteer with our children until the entire process is completed. Families that need to start this process in order to volunteer for activities involving our children, MUST PICK UP A PACKET OF INFORMATION AND FORMS IN THE OFFICE.





SCRIP Gift Card Fundraiser: Use our SCRIP gift cards for your EVERY DAY purchases! Here's how it works: rather than going to the grocery store and paying

with your credit card, buy a gift card for that same store from FAW, then use that gift card when you check out. We carry gift cards for all of the local grocery stores including McKays, BJs, Food Lion, Giant, Target and Walmart. (Food Lion, Target and Walmart are available in electronic gift cards and are available immediately when purchased using your linked bank account.)





Phone calls to change a dismissal routine for any child **must be made by 2pm**.



Handbook Highlight: "Pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, first, second, and third grade students are evaluated on age-appropriate skills and archdiocesan academic standards. Their report cards will indicate the progress they make in attaining their grade level skills.

Letter grades will be awarded to students in Grades 4-8 using the following scale:

A – 93% - 100% B – 85% - 92% C – 77% - 84% D – 70% - 76% F – below 70%

Students will be promoted or retained on the recommendation of the teachers and the principal based on their evaluation of the students' cognitive ability, performance, maturity, and the regulations of the Archdiocese of Washington."

St. Vincent de Paul's virtual Walk for the Poor - September 26th

Walk for the Poor is going virtual! Because of COVID-19, this year's St. Vincent de Paul Walk for the Poor won't be a physical event. Instead, on September 26th there is a Virtual Walk for the Poor, Take a walk with your family in your neighborhood, on the soccer field, or through Leonardtown.

Every dollar raised benefits people in need who live in St. Mary's County. Last year, the Walk raised \$17,000 from over 300 walkers and 40 sponsors. Our St. Vincent de Paul conference at St. Aloysius helped nearly 900 St. Mary's County residents with basic needs including rent, electric, water, food and medicine.
