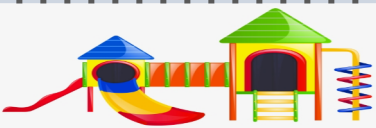

CELEBRATE CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK 2021

January 31 - February 6 #CSW21

Catholic Schools Week starts January 31st. To kick off the weeklong celebration, each of our three parishes will highlight our school at the Masses that weekend. Handbook Highlight: "Accessories: In keeping with the simplicity of a uniform, accessories should be minimal as follows:

- Wristwatches may be worn (those with sound capabilities should be set to silent mode)
- Bracelets or hair ties of any kind worn on the wrist are not permitted
- Due to the standalone capability of some models/brands to send and receive text messages and take pictures, no smartwatches of any kind (i.e. Apple Watch, Android Watch, etc.) may be worn at any time, even if their "smart" functions can be 'turned off'
- Rings of any kind are not to be worn
- A plain chain necklace with a cross or religious medal is the only necklace that may be worn
- Modest, appropriate stud earrings (one in each ear) may be worn – in the interest of safety, no hoops of any size nor any dangling earrings are permissible
- For safety reasons, no jewelry is to be worn on PE days
- No make-up is not to be worn to school
- No nail polish, artificial nails, or French manicures (regardless of out-of-school commitments)
- Visible body markings such as temporary tattoos must be covered with a bandage until they have worn off or been removed
- Students may not draw tattoo-like markings on any visible parts of their bodies with pens or markers"
