Handbook Highlight: "Our school regulations are based on Christian principles and the concepts of common courtesy and respect. The following are school rules which will be the basic criteria for behavior expected of students at Father Andrew White, SJ School: In the school, on the playground, in the lunchroom, on field trips or in any place that can be considered a school function, students must treat others with dignity and respect.

- Inappropriate language, derogatory remarks, insolence or disrespect to any adult or peer, unwelcome physical contact, roughness, and fighting will not be tolerated.
- In the classroom students must conduct themselves in an orderly manner and adhere to the rules established in individual classrooms. Attention must be given to the teacher and the task at hand.
- All class work and homework assignments are to be neat, complete, and turned in on time. When working in groups, conversational tones are expected.
- Honesty and trustworthiness are character traits that are expected. Lying, cheating, and stealing are considered serious infractions and may result in disciplinary action at the discretion of the principal."




