Quarantine Learning Plan



It is our hope that we will be able to have all of our students continue with in-person learning for the duration of the 2021-2022 school year. We realize there may be times when individuals or groups of students and teachers may have to quarantine due to COVID-19. In an effort to ensure learning still continues during a quarantine, we have developed a temporary quarantine learning plan. Changes to this plan (if needed) will be communicated with affected families throughout the year.

If a full class is required to quarantine:

- ❖ Students will receive a schedule that outlines each day for the duration of the quarantine.
 - ❖ Students **may** be expected to log in to their classes via Google Meet for live learning at the times designated on the schedule.
 - ❖ The schedule will be condensed to fit the needs and attention span of the learners. **Only core classes of Religion, Math, and Language Arts will be taught (along with Science, Social Studies and Spanish in Middle School only).** Students in grades PK - 5 will complete independent activities for Science and Social Studies classes. Specials classes (Art, Music, PE, Library/Technology) will be modified.

If individual students are required to quarantine, but the rest of the class is in school:

Please note: In order to participate in the modified distance learning, parents must provide a doctor's note or communication from the health department to the school. To be clear, this is only for students quarantining due to COVID-19. This is not available for other illnesses or otherwise missing school for various trips/reasons. **Please contact all of your child's teachers, the office, and the nurse.**

- Students are expected to complete work for classes such as Religion, Math, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies and Spanish (for middle school). Specials work may be given upon return to school with a make up plan provided by the teachers.
- Instruction for students will vary based on grade levels as noted below.

For Pre-K and Kindergarten:

- ★ All required materials will be available for pickup in the school office after 24 (business) hours from when parents inform the teacher.
- ★ Teachers will provide worksheets to complete and **possibly** videos to watch at home at their discretion. Seesaw may be used in lieu of paper copies.

For Grades 1-2:

- ★ All books and required materials will be available for pickup in the school office after 24 (business) hours from when parents inform the teacher.
- ★ The teacher will communicate with parents and answer any assignment questions as needed via email or phone.

- ★ The teacher will use Seesaw to assign lessons or will provide packets of work to be completed by students from home.
- ★ Work will be submitted using Seesaw and/or when students return to school. Extensions will be given to students who are unable to complete assignments due to illness.
- ★ All absent work and books must come back with the student upon his/her first return day to school.

For Grades 3-5:

- ★ All books and required materials will be available for pickup in the school office after 24 (business) hours from when parents inform the teacher.
- ★ The teacher will communicate regularly with parents via email or phone.
- ★ Teachers **may** post learning videos and links to aid in completing assignments.
- ★ All assignments will be posted in Google Classroom.
- ★ Work will be submitted using Google Classroom and/or when students return to school. Extensions will be given to students who are unable to complete assignments due to illness.
- ★ Students who are quarantining at home due to COVID-19 exposure can schedule an appointment after school via Google Meet if the student needs additional assistance with work.
- ★ All absent work and books must come back with the student upon his/her first return day to school.

For Grades 6-8:

- ★ All books and required materials will be available for pickup in the school office after 24 (business) hours from when parents inform the teacher(s).
- ★ The teachers will communicate regularly with students via Google Classroom. Parents may contact teachers via email or phone for clarification on any assignments.
- ★ Daily work will be communicated on the grade level homework pages on the FAW website. Assignments will be posted to Google Classroom for each subject and students should submit their work through Google Classroom.
- ★ Teachers **may** post learning videos and links to aid in completing assignments. Some of the assigned school work will be self directed and self paced; however, teachers may record part of their lesson and post it to Google Classroom for students at home to view. Recording lessons **will be at the discretion of the individual teacher** and based on the content being taught and the method of instruction.
- ★ Work will be submitted using Google Classroom and/or when students return to school. Extensions will be given to students who are unable to complete assignments due to illness.
- ★ Students who are quarantining at home due to COVID-19 exposure can schedule an appointment after school via Google Meet if the student needs additional assistance with work.
- ★ All absent work and books must come back with the student upon his/her first return day to school.
