

The FIRST LEGO League Robotics team worked hard to participate in the regional competition in January. Students of all ages have enjoyed our new GaGa Ball court and our newlypainted back parking lot during recess. Each day, the students have an opportunity to practice their faith through our Buddy Program, in their religion classes or around the community through service activities.



This year's 2024 Annual Giving Campaign is dedicated to updating and enhancing the Math Program for our entire student body. 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Last week I reviewed some of the reasons students are currently coming to see me, and most of the issues coincide with the time of year: "Spring fever," summer colds, allergies, bugs, rashes, and dehydration. Being injured is also at the top of the list (especially scraped knees since most are wearing shorts). I have also seen a few students who have become a bit overheated while playing outside. When this happens the best treatment is to simply move to a cooler environment, rehydrate, and rest. Being overheated can become severe, however, and lead to heat exhaustion or heat stroke, which are medical emergencies. (When in doubt, seek help!) While spending time outdoors can be loads of fun, it can also present some challenges. To be prepared, you may want to keep a few things on hand: bug spray, sunscreen, aloe (after sun care), itch cream, tick remover, ice packs (or Ziploc bags), and water (for drinking and cleaning).




