

MANDATORY SCRIP PURCHASE

2017/18 school year



1. What is SCRIP?
SCRIP means gift card.
2. How much will I have to purchase?
Each family will have to purchase about \$1,500 to \$2,000 in face value in order to generate \$75 in profit.
3. How does this work?
FAW purchases gift cards at a discount and sells them at face value which allows the school to make a profit on each gift card.
4. How do I use the gift cards?
For every day purchases like gas, groceries, dining, household supplies, movies, hotels, Amazon and more.
5. How will this be tracked?
A report of each family's SCRIP profit will be sent home at the end of the first and third quarters. You can also look up your family's SCRIP purchases in your own on-line SCRIP account.
6. How long do I have to make these purchases?
The reporting period is June 1, 2017 through May 31, 2018.
7. Where do I buy SCRIP gift cards?
You can send an order form and check to school; order on-line and pay by check or Presto Pay at www.shopwithscrip.com; purchase after Mass at St. Aloysius; or purchase on Friday afternoons in the car rider line. We have a number of gift cards from local retailers in stock, and can order many more, including national chain retailers.
8. Can I opt out?
Yes. You can write a check for \$75 to cover this requirement without buying gift cards.
