**SCRIP:** If you are planning to shop on Black Friday or Cyber Monday, remember to use scrip! Set up Presto Pay to allow you to access e-cards almost immediately! Before you checkout online or in store, tally your purchases and buy a scrip e-card. Enter the code or show your phone to the cashier. If you prefer to use a physical card, we have a number of retailers in stock including Amazon, Under Armour, Old Navy, Gap, Dick's, Best Buy, and Cabelas. If we don't have what you need in stock, **we will place an order tomorrow, November 15th** for delivery before Thanksgiving break.

**Flu Shots:** St. Mary's County Health Department is holding one more flu shot clinic at their facility in November. The date is **November 15th** from 8:00am - 12:00pm. No appointments are needed. Flu shots will be given on a walk-in basis. Flu shots are free for children ages 6 months to 18 years old. Adults are a \$25 fee. St. Mary's Health Department is located at 21580 Peabody Street, Leonardtown, MD. This will be our only opportunity for Flu clinics through the health department. They have already held their clinics at the local public schools.
