

free until 5pm. Be sure to check out the Education buildings to see our wonderful display of artwork! Our FAW artists are talented! Enjoy the Fair!







NEW TO VOLUNTEERING AT FAW?

<u>Child Protection Volunteer Requirements:</u> For our new families and as a reminder for our returning families, don't forget the archdiocesan requirements for anyone who wishes to volunteer for activities that involve interaction with our children (ex. coaching, classroom or cafeteria helper, chaperone on field trips,



etc.). The Archdiocese of Washington Child Protection Policy requires volunteers in parishes and schools to set up an account at virtus.org, complete a volunteer application, get fingerprints taken, and attend a (virtual) training session on the Child Protection Policy. Upon completion of the training session, the last page in the policy book must be signed and returned to the school office. No one may volunteer with our children until the entire process is completed. Families that need to start this process in order to volunteer for activities involving our children, may visit our website <u>HERE</u> for step by step instructions.


