
Book Fair Thank You

Have you ever tried "Breathing Exercises"? They are actually super beneficial – not just for your lungs, but for your whole body.

Something as simple as taking slow, deep breaths can improve lung capacity, cardiovascular function, sleep patterns,



concentration/focus, and overall autonomic function. It also helps reduce blood pressure, stress

and anxiety, inflammation, and even oxidative stress. Since exercise, in general, helps keep us in shape, breathing exercises can be thought of as a way to keep your lungs in shape.




Social & Auction this April, but we need teams in place to continue with the rest of the planning! Here are the positions that we need filled immediately:
