Intermediate students are exploring different types of writing. Second and third graders are writing poems (rhyming poems and haikus), fourth graders are writing personal narratives and fifth graders are learning how to write with a purpose.

Seventh graders created projects using macaroni to demonstrate knowledge of how cells work together to create organisms. Our eighth grade students have finished learning about the Revolutionary war and are beginning their topic of studying the United States Constitution as well as the meaning of $E = mc^2$.
