





It can be gradual or hit you out of nowhere – the dreaded stomach bug! Another word for this lovely illness is gastroenteritis which is actually an inflammation of the lining of the stomach and intestines, and usually results from bacterial toxins or viral infections. The most common symptoms are nausea, vomiting, pain, diarrhea, and sometimes low grade fever; and the best treatment is rest and fluids. There are also medicines that can help such as antiemetics (for vomiting) and anti-diarrheals. Fortunately, if you can hang in there and endure the misery, the infectious agent will exit your system within a few days. Just follow good infection control, since it's often contagious, and stay hydrated (to avoid a trip to the ER for IV fluids). "Stomachaches" aren't always infectious gastroenteritis, since other things can cause similar symptoms (too much sugar or junk food, being nervous or anxious, swinging too hard on the tire swing, etc.) Whatever the cause, when recovering, it's best to start off eating small amounts of bland foods (such as the BRAT diet - bananas, rice, applesauce, and toast); and, of course, avoid the cause if at all possible.
