

- Do you want to know how to keep your children safe in Cyberspace?
- Do you want to know how to better monitor what your children are doing online?
- Do you want tools for keeping youth safe in Cyberspace?





Joe Dugan Internet Safety Specialist, Maryland State Police will provide a presentation that will:

- Equip you with an understanding of the dangers of social networking, gaming sites, smart phone/tablet apps, disturbing trends such as cyberbullying, tactics online predators use to lure youth into dangerous and potentially life-threatening situations.
- Discuss the many ways our children can find themselves in trouble on the internet, such as loss of privacy and exposure to graphic content both from imagery and online games.

Our RaiseRight (formerly known as SCRIP) Program year, is coming to an end on March 31st. There is still time for you to grab gift cards for your everyday purchases, gifts for Easter baskets, Mother's Day, etc. There are all kinds of things coming up that you can be well prepared for. Gift cards can be purchased as e-gift cards which you receive instantly or physical gift cards, some of which are reloadable via the App or online.

Thank you so much to all the families and friends that have participated thus far this year. Not only is the school earning money back but we have multiple families earning back rebates that will offset their tuition for next year! How can you check to see if you earned extra rebates? Remember that the first \$50 in rebates goes to our school. Everything raised thereafter gets a 75/25 split. To clarify, 75% goes towards your child's tuition (or the 8th grade trip if you prefer) for next year and 25% goes back to FAW. A simple way to check your rebates that you have earned thus far for the year is via the App: https://apps.apple.com/us/app/raiseright-fundraising/id1498234012. It allows you to filter by the appropriate dates (April 1, 2022 - March 31, 2023) and displays your total rebate.





Ah, beautiful springtime - it's right around the corner! I find myself praising God every morning as I wake to hear the birds singing and see the beautiful flowers blooming. Of course I know it always brings with it copious pollen and dreaded allergies. For those that suffer from allergies, this probably means increasing allergy medications, and dealing with itchy, watery eyes, stuffiness, sneezing and incessant coughing. Even if you do not have seasonal allergies, we all still inhale what is in the air around us, and this by itself can cause similar symptoms due to increased mucus in our airways (which is used to trap and expel irritants by blowing our nose and coughing). To help with this you may want to use saline rinses, both nasal and oral (i.e. gargling with salt water), and air purifiers. You can also check the allergy forecast - https://allergyasthmanetwork.org/weather/ - in order to "know before you go" and enjoy the beautiful upcoming spring days.



GUEST SPEAKER SERIES AT ST. FRANCIS XAVIER

Join us at St. Francis Xavier Hall in Compton on March 22, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. for a talk on the history of the Jesuits by Reverend David J. Collins, SJ. Fr. Collins, born and raised "inside the beltway," is currently the director of Catholic Studies and a history professor at Georgetown University. He has been a Jesuit since 1987, was ordained a priest in 1998, and earned his Ph.D. in History from Northwestern University in 2004. Fr. Collins is first and foremost a historian of medieval science and religion but has been responsible for passing on the colonial history of the Jesuit order in Maryland to Jesuits in training for the last twenty years. 


