Mother, please have your child bring them in to school this Thursday, May 4th so we can prepare bouquets. Thank you for your help!




Band/Chorus Concert





May 8th-12th: Pie and Dollars for DI



We ended the day with a whole school assembly where students showed off their faith t-shirts and listened to Fr. Wyble's testimony. Students learned an Easter call and response from Fr. David and a chant from the Sisters from the Servants of the Lord and the Virgin Matara. Mrs. Vavrus's love for the Lord shined through as she emphasized our theme, "Thy Word is a Lamp Unto My Feet."
