

- 1. Sign up for the day(s) you want the spirit rock to be viewed. You may begin decorating the spirit rock at 3:00 PM the day BEFORE you sign up. Similarly, the person who signs up for the next day may begin decorating the rock at 3:00 PM on the last day you have reserved. Therefore, spirit rock reservations run from 3:00 PM the day BEFORE you sign up through 3:00 PM the day of your sign up.
- 2. Spirit rock fees are \$20.00 per day. Please pay via the link in Benefact once your reservation is made on SignUp Genius.
- 3. Payment is due at the time of making the reservation and is 1st come, 1st served. All payments and reservations are non-refundable for any reason (changed your mind, inclement weather, etc). However, if you decide you do not want your date, you can offer it to a friend or sell it to another family. However, the school will not offer refunds on any reserved dates.
- 4. You are responsible for providing all materials for decorating the spirit rock. You are expected to ensure the area around the spirit rock remains clean, free of trash and debris. You should ensure that paint is not left on the road, curb or grass. BEFORE PAINTING: please hang the provided drop cloths on the hooks on the building, and place around the rock to cover the grass. The bin of drop cloths is located just inside the gym door. You are responsible for collecting the materials before you paint, and returning them promptly when finished painting.
- 5.A reminder e-mail will be sent 2 days before your reservation date via Sign Up Genius. Please make sure to note on your personal calendar the day(s) you have reserved the Spirit Rock. FAW is not responsible for missed or forgotten reservations.
- 6.We encourage families to paint the rock together as a fun activity not just for birthdays, but to spread positive messages and encouragement to our fellow students, teachers and community! Show off your creativity! We will keep a digital photo album on our website, featuring photos of the Spirit Rock all year long!

## Spirit Rock Tips

- Wear Old Clothes
- Wall paint or spray paint will work best on the rock. It may take 2-4 cans of spray paint to make a base coat on the rock. Spray paint may dry faster than latex paint.
- Please be respectful of the school grounds and the environment!
