




BAND FESTIVAL



RaiseRight Update/Reminder



Our RaiseRight Gift Card Program year is coming to an end on March 31st. There is still time for you to grab gift cards for your everyday purchases, gifts for Easter baskets, Mother's Day, etc. There are all kinds of things coming up that you can be well prepared for with gift cards! Gift cards can be purchased as e-gift cards which you receive instantly or physical gift cards, some of

which are reloadable via the App or online.

Thank you so much to all the families and friends that have participated thus far this year. Not only is the school earning money back but we have multiple families earning back rebates that will offset their tuition for next year! How can you check to see if you earned extra rebates? Remember that the first \$50 in rebates goes to our school. Everything raised thereafter gets a 75/25 split. On behalf of the Father Andrew White (FAW) School Family, we thank everyone who generously donated to last year's Annual Giving Campaign. Since last year, our students have been hard at work! The students have been diving diligently into their classwork, learning through hands-on experiences, field trips and real-world applications. The FIRST LEGO League Robotics team worked hard to participate in the regional competition in January. Students of all ages have enjoyed our new GaGa Ball court and our newly-painted back parking lot during recess. Each day, the students have an opportunity to practice their faith through our Buddy Program, in their religion classes or around the community through service activities.

This year's 2024 Annual Giving Campaign is dedicated to updating and enhancing the Math Program for our entire student body. You may have seen recently that the CDC is updating its COVID guidelines, and removing the five day isolation mandate. Accordingly, the MD Dept. of Health and Dept. of Education have issued a memorandum directing schools and child care providers to follow the <u>Respiratory Virus Guidance</u> recently issued by the CDC. This guidance provides recommendations for prevention strategies for several common respiratory viruses including COVID-19, influenza, and RSV. Additionally, the precautions listed to prevent the spread are the same for all respiratory viruses (and most communicable diseases, in general) which are to keep your child home if he or she is sick until symptoms have improved and there has been no fever for 24 hours. Once your child does return to school, he or she should be extra careful to avoid spreading germs (by hand washing, covering coughs, etc.). Of course, if your child's sickness warrants a visit to the pediatrician, you will be given further instructions specific to his or her situation and needs. Ultimately it comes down to how your child is feeling, and we universally desire for all God's children to be healthy and happy.


