RaiseRight Update/Reminder



Our RaiseRight Gift Card Program year is coming to an end on March 31st. There is still time for you to grab gift cards for your everyday purchases, gifts for Easter baskets, Mother's Day, etc. There are all kinds of things coming up that you can be well prepared for with gift cards! Gift cards can be purchased as e-gift cards which you receive instantly or physical gift cards, some of

Since last year, our students have been hard at work! The students have been diving diligently into their classwork, learning through hands-on experiences, field trips and real-world applications. The FIRST LEGO League Robotics team worked hard to participate in the regional competition in January. Students of all ages have enjoyed our new GaGa Ball court and our newlypainted back parking lot during recess. Each day, the students have an opportunity to practice their faith through our Buddy Program, in their religion classes or around the community through service activities.

NOTES FROM NURSE ROSE

Each week FAW has a root word that we incorporate into student lessons. Last week the root word was "spec" (meaning - look, see), so I immediately thought of "spectacles" and want to thank those who have donated used glasses to our ongoing Lions Club collection. I also thank God for His wonderful gift of sight and stress the importance of taking care of our eyes. Unfortunately, our eyes are constantly exposed to potential hazards, such as injury (from foreign objects, chemicals, etc.) and long term damage from the sun's ultraviolet light (which can harm the retina, cause the development of cloudy bumps along the edge of the cornea, and contribute to the development of cataracts). On April 8th, portions of the US will experience a solar eclipse, which, when viewed directly without protection, can cause immediate eye damage. This can range from temporary visual impairment to burns of the retina and permanent blindness. There are special glasses that can be used to view the eclipse, but do not look at it without them. Solar eclipses are rare and auite a site to see. Just be sure to protect your eves - to keep them for future viewing!




