Tuition Rates and Fees

Costs to Educate

The cost to educate a student at Father Andrew White, S.J. School (FAW) is determined based on the total budgeted expenses for the academic year divided by the budgeted enrollment. The cost to educate for the 2025-2026 school year is as follows:

Description of Fees

New application and re-enrollment fees are non-refundable and paid through FACTS at the time of registration. The \$400 Instructional Materials/Activities fee and \$240 Pre-K Materials Fee are included on your FACTS billing invoice. These fees will cover instructional materials throughout the school year, general school supplies (previously on the school supply list) and whole school activities (ex. Camp Maria retreat, Grandparents Day supplies, Faith Rally materials).

FACTS

FAW partners with FACTS for tuition collection and processing. Payments can be made online via automatic bank draw (ACH) or automatic credit card charge or via manual payments directly to the school office upon receipt of a statement. Families select their payment preferences when completing the online tuition agreement in FACTS.

Families will establish a payment plan at the time of enrollment. Any financial aid will be applied by the end of June 2025.
