Notes from the Bookkeeper

The Financial Aid application for the 2026-2027 school year is open!

This application is the starting point for ALL requests for financial assistance from Father Andrew White School.

Although we've just started the school year, the financial aid application is open for next year and we encourage you to fill it out early. To qualify for any tuition assistance, you must submit this application. Once you have completed the application, please keep an eye on your email for any requests for additional information from FACTS - failure to provide any requested information will result in an incomplete application, which will not be considered for financial aid.

The due date is February 1, 2026. The application will request 2024 tax information, so there's no need to wait until the new year to start your application.

To fill in an application, log into your FACTS Family Portal and click on **Financial** on the left side. Then click on **Apply for Grant & Aid**. From there, click on **Create your Account** to start your financial aid application.





Simply the right way to fundraise



With Christmas coming, this is a great time to purchase gift cards to use for your own Christmas shopping or to give as gifts. You can always order electronic cards through your online account. Physical cards can be picked up three ways at the Thanksgiving Luncheon:

- 1. Place an order online through the app and submit payment ahead of time for physical cards by **November 10th. Be sure to select "Ship to Coordinator."** We will have your cards ready for you to pick up at the Thanksgiving luncheon.
- 2. You can submit a <u>physical order form</u>, which lists our current stock of gift cards, to the school with payment by **November 19th.** You can then collect them at the Thanksgiving luncheon. Please use the Raise Right order form below.
- 3. You can bring your checkbook or cash to purchase cards from our stock that day.

our troops who will not be with family during the holidays.


In order to collect the items, put the stockings together and have them delivered in time for Christmas, we need the items by Wednesday, November 12th.




