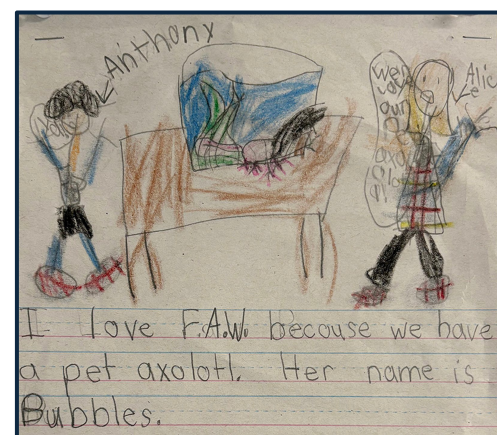
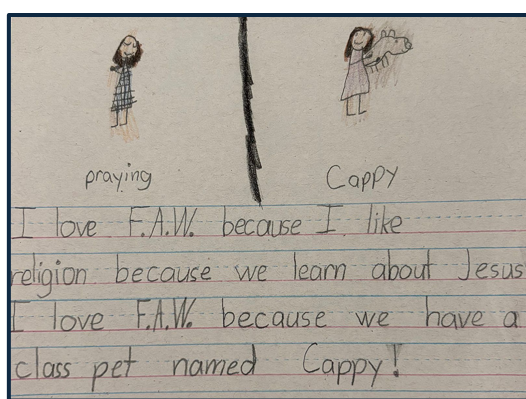

NOTES FROM NURSE ROSE

Cold weather advisories are definitely in effect! What does that mean healthwise? Preventing injury is a priority, so wear shoes with good traction and pay attention when you are walking to prevent falls. The saying, "You can't catch a cold from being cold" may be true as it relates to the cold virus, but cold temperatures can definitely contribute to sickness. While we should still go outside to get fresh air and sunshine (and vitamin D), inhaling cold air directly can irritate and dry out the respiratory tract causing chapped lips, runny nose, sore throat, coughing, and nosebleeds, and can trigger asthma attacks and heart related problems. Simple exposure can cause dry, cracked skin, earaches, tissue damage, frostbite, and hypothermia. Thus, simply adding a layer of protection can go a long way. Now that we're back to school, we'll be spending more time inside together - which is the actual reason that we catch colds more often in winter. Thus, please take extra precautions to prevent the spread of germs by reminding your children to wash hands and cover coughs and sneezes. Additionally, if they are sick, please keep them home until feeling well enough to be at school.
